

Top Soil Depth: 0.70 m loamy soil with surface gravel. Subsoil Type: Alluvial round rocks covered with limestone.

Floral, dried berries, currants and dark spice aromas. Beautiful, linear and medium acidity.

WINEMAKING

Fermentation in roll-fermentor and stainless steel tanks. The parcela was fermented with 20% whole cluster. Average fermentation temperature 25 degrees. 12 days maceration. Malolactic fermentation in barrels.
